At Pacific World School our little Pacificans learn skills, acquire new knowledge and demonstrate their understanding through 7 areas of learning and development.

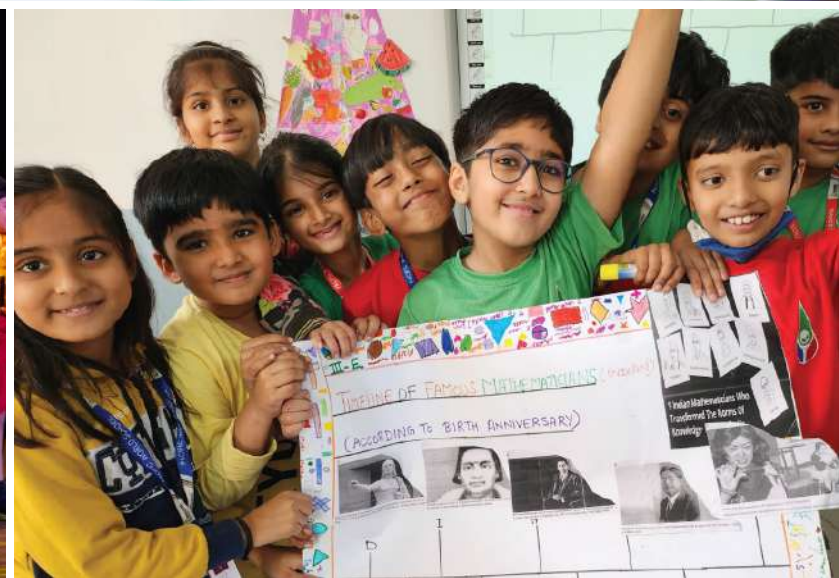

Preparatory Stage (III to V)

Since its inception, Pacific World School is striving to make a transition from content to competencies. This holds more importance in the preparatory stage of a student's life. In the preparatory stage, the students form sound study habits and develop skill sets necessary to operate in social settings. The lesson plans are designed to be more learner centric and exploratory. We do not see the scholastic and co scholastic subjects in isolation, rather a typical school day witnesses a beautiful amalgamation of all spheres of learning, integrated with each other. Safety and Security of Students

- The entire support staff is verified by the police and only female staff is deputed in the academic block.

- The school has a fully equipped ambulance and a tie-up with a nearby hospital for all emergencies.
- The school has installed a state-of-the-art fire-fighting system.

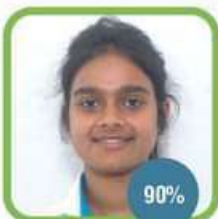
